STEM Week



Each year we hold our STEM week (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths), to further the children's enthusiasm for these subjects and give them a range of experiences to help them understand the world around them. The children have really enjoyed all of the STEM activities and some were so excited for this week, that on Monday, they chose to wish us all a 'Happy STEM week'. On Monday we had visitors from Milton Keynes Recycling Centre and Sarah Craig, an aerospace engineer, who talked to us

about the phenomenal power of magnets.

On Tuesday, the whole school worked alongside the RAF to design their own sustainable RAF bases which incorporated lots of different renewable energy sources including hydroelectric, solar, wind, wave and biomass.

On Wednesday, we were visited by Pauline and Ken in the morning who showed us some truly magical science which had some people's hair standing on end! Following that, the whole school completed a 'biscuit' experiment to answer the age-old question – Which biscuit is the best?



Finally, on Thursday, Pauline (The Magical Science Lady) joined us again to show the children the amazing chemical reactions that can take place when you mix two substances together.

To round off our STEM week, we spent Thursday afternoon celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. As part of this, the children (and staff!) all dressed up as a person from a time period

during the Queen's reign. During the afternoon, the children were able to take part in traditional playground

games, such as 'Duck Duck Goose' and 'What is the time Mr.Wolf?' as well as traditional fayre games such as 'Bash a Rat', 'Hook a Duck' and Mini-Golf. The children also enjoyed a range of party food – which they loved!
